
ALL INDIA BACKWARD CLASSES FEDERATION


MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION


1. **Name of The Society** : The name of the society shall be "ALL INDIA BACKWARD CLASSES FEDERATION"
2. **Registered Office** : The Registered Office of the Federation shall be at National Capital Territory of Delhi, and at present it's at the following address :- H NO. 253 POOTH KHURD DELHI-110039.
3. **Area Of Operation** : ALL OVER INDIA. This organisation will be called "ALL INDIA BACKWARD CLASSES FEDERATION" and here in after will be referred to as Federation.
4. **Jurisdiction** :- The jurisdiction shall be throughout the State of Delhi.
5. **For the purposes of the Federation:** "Backward Classes" are those classes as are constitutionally recognized and notified by the government of India from time to time. As on today they are the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes However, in view of their vulnerabilities all religious Minorities will form part of the broad definition of this Federation. This Federation does not take into consideration economic backwardness as the sole criteria for any class of people to be part of it, though it is not averse to help such people in times of need on the basis of occupation cum income on case to case basis"

6. AIMS & OBJECTS:

The Aims and Objects of the Federation, for which the same is established, are as under:





- 6.1 To improve the conditions of socially and educationally backward classes (hereinafter referred to as "BCs") in India and to take steps to remove such difficulties under which they labour and to make appropriate representations and recommendations to the Central and State Governments and for necessary grants to remove such difficulties and to improve their conditions.
- 6.2 To educate and enlighten the socially and educationally backward classes for the unity and to secure the social, economic and political justice for them and also to work out for the equality of status and of equal opportunity and to promote among the backward classes the fraternity assuring the dignity of individual and the unity and integrity of the nation.
- 6.3 To ensure the proper implementation of reservations to all the backward classes relating to their admissions to educational institutions including private educational institutions, whether aided or un-aided by the State under Article 15(4) and Article 15(5) of the Constitution of India.
- 6.4 Work to ensure equality of opportunity in the matters of public employment and adequate representation for OBCs in the services under the Central and State Governments including the Public Sector at all levels and cadres.
- 6.5 To treat un-equals as equals is to perpetuate inequality. The humanness of the society is determined by the degree of protection it provides to its weak and the disadvantaged. Therefore, reservations are required to the BCs in all fields.
- 6.6 To take steps for the proper implementation of Fundamental Rights and to fulfil the objectives of the Directive Principles of the Constitution of India.





- 6.7 To ensure caste based enumeration of socio-economic cast census of the all the citizens of India indicating social, educational, economic, employment, cultural and political status for the purpose of scientific approach to the implementation of reservations in education, employment and representation. Realistic census is required for the implementation of socio-economic development and welfare of all.
- 6.8 To demand political reservations not only in the Legislative Assemblies and in the Parliament; in the Higher Judiciary and in all other nominated Public Appointments.
- 6.9 Work to improve the conditions of the underprivileged people including children and women who are suffering from malnutrition and disease due to poverty and unemployment; abolition of private sector in primary education and health; and establish uniform public facilities for the same.
- 6.10 To undertake the programs and work to ensure equal distribution of wealth and sources of income by way of public works to all the backward classes to achieve economic equality.
- 6.11 The employment is diminishing in the Government Sector and increasing in the Private Sector. Therefore, all the Private Sector Undertakings which have received financial assistance from the Government in one form or other should also be obliged to recruit OBCs, SCs and STs as in the case of public sector. Similar policy to be adopted in all the private sector Universities and their affiliated colleges in respect of all the posts.
- 6.12 Educate and enlighten all the Backward Classes - the SCs, STs, OBCs, Sikh, Muslim and Christians to share their genuine political representation in proportion to their population; and build brotherhood among these classes to the unity and integrity if India.
- 6.13 To take up effective and lawful steps for eradication of social evils such as untouchability, social discrimination, dowry system, girl child marriage, child labour etc.







- 6.14 To build and establish a value based society without corruption, exploitation, oppression, suppression, discrimination and to provide quality education imparting moral, spiritual and value based character of human beings for an enlightened society and a strong Indian nation.
- 6.15 The purpose of this organisation is to unite the various recognised Backward Castes and class unions into one and increase the awareness among the Backward Classes of their rights guaranteed by the Constitution of India for social, political and economic justice and to engage them to fight for their rights peacefully. To sustain social justice movement; to motivate and educate the people from different walks of life and from different parts of the country to promote the Constitutional "VISION" of Social, Economic, and Political Justice and Social Transformation of India and the "MISSION" to secure the Constitutional Democracy.
- 6.16 To organise the BC movement by bringing the various Associations, Organisations, Sangams, Societies working at the village, district, state and national level under the Umbrella of All India BC Federation to achieve the stated Objectives.-
- 6.17 To support and ensure a People-Centered Society, by especially channelizing the potential of socially marginalised people into action groups for their self-development and growth by bridging the gap between needs and resources.
- 6.18 To improve cultural, educational and social condition of the people by undertaking multidisciplinary programs and work for democracy, good governance, realization of human right, international peace, justice and cooperation including NGOs cooperation and coordination programs.
- 6.19 To erect, open, establish, maintain, manage, support, contribute to or assist charitable hospitals, dispensaries, blood banks, eye bank, pathology diagnostic lab, ambulance services, nursing colleges, maternity homes and other like institutions for the benefit of any person or persons regardless of gender, community, caste, creed, race or nationality.





- 6.20 To undertake, develop and construct sports and games facilities including hostels and organize competitions to improve physical and mental health of the Backward Classes.
- 6.21 To undertake, develop, manage or organise antique show, audio and video show, fashion show, thematic puppet show, charity show, film show, car rally, dance events, fancy dress competition, greeting card and handicraft exhibition, marketing rural products, endowment of award and prizes and promotion of youth organization.
- 6.22 To promote, undertake or arrange educational tours, Yoga classes, Judo classes, process documentation, media advocacy, distribution of scholarship, cultural activities and provide sports facilities towards development of sports and games including sports complexes.
- 6.23 To mobilise monetary and or other relief and or social assistance in times of famine, floods, earthquakes and other natural calamities to stand by the victims in a manner which will help and uplift the community in general in time of such calamities.
- 6.24 To support manufacturers, traders, and farmers for participation in international fairs, seminars and meetings with a view to create mass awareness about the importance of medicinal plants in all strata of society and explore the international market for plant based herbal products.
- 6.25 To undertake, manage and run postgraduate, undergraduate and diploma level courses in the field of Business Administration, Computer Applications, Engineering and Technology, Architecture/ Planning, Hotel Management and Catering Technology, Pharmacy, Applied Arts and Crafts.
- 6.26 Conduction of Leadership Training Camps/Programmes for students, teachers, organizers. Conduction of seminars, workshops, symposiums for students, intellectuals, colleges, universities, industries etc.







- 6.27 To develop collaborations with Government, NGO's Unions, Associations, Organizations and people to bring under one umbrella for 2nd National Movement for a Progressive India, Casteless India, Enlightened India and Developed India 2040.

- 6.29 To provide for payment of scholarships to students, school or college fees, boarding and lodging charges and purchase or educational books or stationery for poor students.

- 6.31 To open residential schools/colleges to conduct programmes to achieve objectives. To provide help for the schools, colleges, Research Institutions, medical clinics and Dispensaries etc to achieve objectives.
- 6.32 To do such act of public charity not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit, as may be deemed fit and necessary by the Trustees.





7. ANCILLARY OBJECTS:


- 7.1 To receive and collect any gifts, subscriptions and donation either in cash or in any kind of acquired by any other lawful ways and means and spend the same in fulfilment of all or in any of the aims and objects of the society. The income and property(s) of the society shall be applied solely for the promotion and fulfilment of the aims and objects of the society provided, and if any donor intends that the contributions, donations or subscriptions shall be applied to attain any particular objects of the society such contributions, donations and subscriptions shall be spent towards the promotions of that particular objects only.
- 7.2 To acquire by purchase, take on lease, hire or by gift and hold any immovable or moveable properties of any rights or privileges that may be deemed necessary or useful for the advancement of objects of the society.
- 7.3 The income earnings, moveable and immoveable properties of the society shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit on their of shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus or profit or in any manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the society or to any person claiming through any one of more of the present or past members. No member of the society shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immoveable properties of the society or make any profits whatsoever by virtue of his membership.

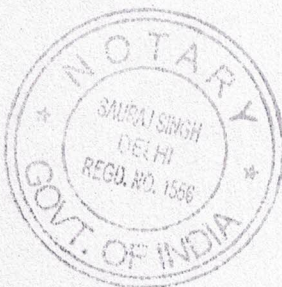

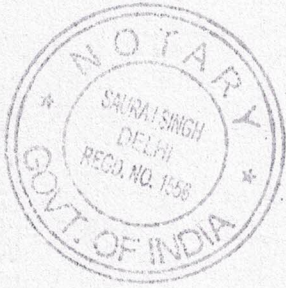
